Remote Learning Guidelines

HELPFUL HINTS & ANSWERS

- Students will need access to high speed internet on either a tablet or laptop. *SeeSaw and Zoom both work well on iPads!
- Students will be expected to log into their SeeSaw account and be engaged each day through videos, lessons, class meetings, or activities.
- The schedule is flexible. Assignments will need to be turned in by midnight on the due date.
- Your child's teacher will remain in touch with them during the week to touch base, see how everyone is doing and provide feedback/ answer questions.
- Your child's teacher will send information with logins, passwords, etc.
- Parents will be asked to commit to a full marking period with either Remote Learning or Traditional/In Person, unless there are extenuating circumstances that require an immediate change (ex. illness/quarantine).
- If your child will continue with Remote Learning after September 4, these guidelines will still apply.
- It is our goal to keep students with their homeroom teacher regardless of Remote or Traditional instruction, but there may be cause to level classes during the year depending on student attendance and enrollment.
