Dear Parents,

Each year the Texas Education Agency (TEA) prepares a Campus Report Card based upon student performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (S.T.A.A.R.) test. The Campus Report Card provides information for Stewart Creek focusing on three performance domains: Student Achievement, School Progress and Closing the Gaps. Based on performance in these domains, campuses earn an accountability rating based on scores that scaled from 0 to 100 to align with letter grades.

Stewart Creek Elementary performed very well in all areas assessed (see table below) and earned an overall campus rating of a **B** with an overall score of 86. Additionally, SCE also earned a distinction in ELA/Reading, Mathematics and Postsecondary Readiness for performing in the top 25% of our campus comparison group.

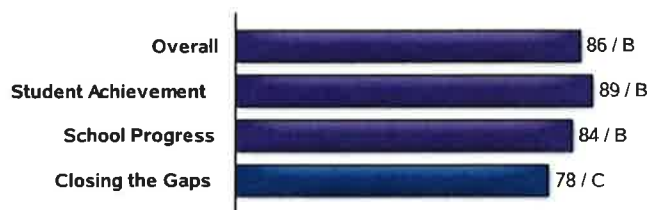
