

Please be aware that under Texas Education Code 22.083 and School Board Policy GKG (LEGAL), the district is authorized to obtain a criminal history record of all applicants and volunteers in the district. The information requested above is necessary to obtain criminal history record information based on *name and DOB* search.

To complete the process:

- Return this completed form to the campus.
- Only one application per volunteer is needed, not per student or campus.
- A background check must be completed each school year.

MISD is not allowed to discuss any criminal history from this search. To clear any misidentification based on the result of the *name and DOB* search, MISD **may** request that a fingerprint search is performed.
