Secondary Summer School Program (Grades 9-12)

The Montgomery I.S.D. High School Summer School program is designed to provide promotional opportunities for students in grades 9-12. Students, who were unable to meet promotion criteria during the regular school year, may enroll for credit recovery in the courses listed below.

Criteria (Core Subjects):

Students enrolled in grade 9-12 during the current school year may attend if at least one of the following criteria is met.

Eligibility:

1. Unable to meet district promotion guidelines in English I, II, III or IV, Algebra I or II, Geometry, World History, World Geography, U.S. History, Government & Economics, IPC, Biology, Chemistry, or Physics;
2. Unable to pass STAAR End of Course Exam (EOC) in Algebra I, English I, English II or Biology (Free);
3. Required to earn credit due to excessive absences during the recent school year. (Free)

For credit purposes, a student's average in summer school will replace the **lowest semester** grade average earned during the school year. The summer school grade will not impact a student's GPA.

Attendance Policy:

In order to receive credit, a student cannot be absent more than one day, excused or unexcused, during the session. Students must be in attendance 18 of the 19 days. One 30 minute tardy is equivalent to one absence. Two 15-minute tardies are equivalent to one absence. Three tardies less than 15 minutes each are equivalent to one absence. Transportation will **NOT** be provided to and from summer school. It is the parent/guardian responsibility to bring their child to the summer program on time and to pick up their child from the summer program on time. Failure to comply with the attendance policy will result in removal of the student for the remainder of the session, even if it occurs late in the session. **This will result in forfeiture of fees and loss of credit.**

Dress Code / Discipline Policies:

The dress code is the Montgomery Independent School District dress code for the regular term. Rules governing student conduct are the same as those for the regular term. **Severe student misconduct and/or 2 discipline referrals will result in removal of the student for the balance of the session, and if required by law, will be placed in DAEP or JJAEP. This will result in the forfeiture of fees and loss of credit.** The principal reserves the right to use his/her discretion.

Transportation:

Summer school will be held at the Montgomery High School East campus. Students need to be dropped off at the front doors. Afterschool pickup will be the same. Student drivers must park in the back parking lot.
