JUNIOR COLLEGE & CAREER READY CHECKLIST

- ◇ Extracurricular Activities: Continue your involvement with extracurricular activities, work and community service. Have you taken a leadership role? Are you a founder of a club?
- ◇ Attend Lunch Bunch College Visits in the MHS Cafeteria and sign up for 30 minute college presentations through the CCC Calendar.
- ◇ Create your free Learning Express account for PSAT, ACT, SAT, and AP Prep. Go by the ASC to learn more.
- ◇ Plan to take the PSAT at MHS on Tuesday, October 15, 2019. **JUNIOR YEAR is MOST IMPORTANT for PSAT.** National Merit Recognition and National Hispanic Recognition Programs and Scholarship Opportunities.
- ◇ Register for ACT & SAT (Take 1x each during the Fall semester & see which you prefer.)
- ◇ Take advantage of using your TWO official college visit days during your Junior year. Bring documentation of your visit from the institution and turn it in to the MHS attendance office on the day of your return. You get TWO official visits your Senior year, as well.
- ◇ Attend College Night Fair at the Lone Star Convention Center from 6:30 P.M. - 8:30 P.M. on October 7th, 2019 if you never have before.
- ◇ Not sure what you want to major in? Register to take the ASVAB through the CCC website. It is free and will take place on November 19th, 2019.
- ◇ Explore the High School Resources for students and parents at www.texasoncourse.org.
- ◇ Are you interested in playing D1 or D2 sports after graduation? Set up your NCAA Student Account through the NCAA Eligibility Center.
- ◇ **SAVE the DATE** to attend our 4th Annual Junior Round-Up event with your parents on Tuesday, February 4th, 2020 from 6-8 PM. This event is for all MISD Juniors. MHS will host it this year!
- ◇ Plan a SOLID summer filled with volunteering, work & camps. Keep track of all your volunteer hours and activities. Sign up for a College Application Essay & Resume Writing Workshop through the College & Career Center. Apply Texas opens July 1st and The Common App opens August 1 the summer leading into your Senior year.
- ◇ What does your digital footprint say about you? College admissions, military, and college coaches look at your social media accounts. Keep your online reputation "In Check".
- ◇ Reach out to teachers who know you well and ask if they would be willing to write a letter of recommendation for you for college applications. Give them at least two weeks notice. Give them a copy of your resume or student brag sheet to use as a reference. Have at least one teacher recommendation in your hand before you leave for summer.
- ◇ Request official copies of your six semester transcript to be sent electronically to the colleges you plan to apply to before you leave for the summer. The transcript request form is in the front office. Allow 24-48 hours for requests to be processed. If you are not sure where you are applying to, you can come up to school during summer hours to complete the form.
- ◇ Continue YOUR momentum into Senior year with rigorous courses. Be careful with late arrivals and early dismissals.
