4. Disciplinary referral

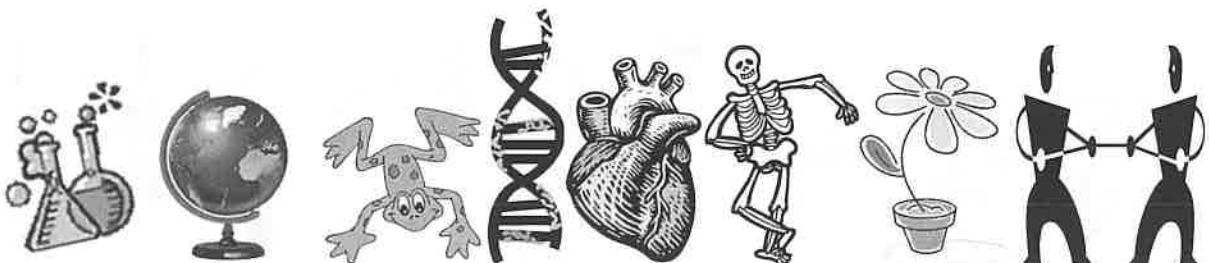
\*\*If a student is severely disruptive (ex: fighting, using inappropriate language, etc.) he/she will be sent to assistant principal immediately.

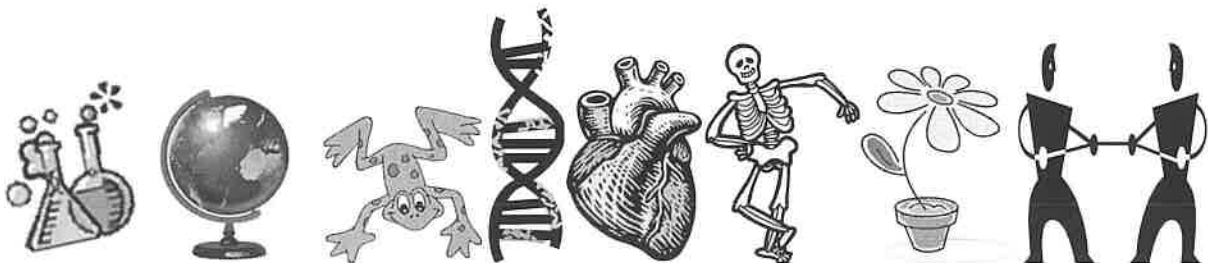
